<i>Students are typically considered dependent if they are born after January 1, 1987, have no children or other dependents, are not married, have not served in the armed forces.</i>	<i>Students are typically considered independent if they are born before January 1, 1987, are married, have children and/or other dependents, have served or are presently in the armed forces. Students whose parents are both deceased, or who have been in foster care, a ward of the court or under legal guardianship may also qualify for independent status.</i>
You must bring the following for <u>both you and your parents.</u>	You must bring the following for <u>both you and your spouse.</u>
2009 Federal Tax Return (including W-2)	Your and your spouse's 2009 Federal Tax Return (including W-2)
2009 Untaxed Income	2009 Untaxed Income
